08:00 A.M. MORNING STROLL AT UTSUBO PARK

3:00 P.M. NAKANOSHIMA CHILDREN'S BOOK FOREST

Continue your cultural journey with a visit to the Nakanoshima Children's Book Forest. Designed and donated by renowned architect Tadao Ando, this serene sanctuary welcomes visitors of all ages to reconnect with the joy of reading. *Please note that advance reservations or entry conditions may apply.

5:00 P.M. FUJITA ART MUSEUM

Move toward a place where art and history are preserved in quiet elegance. Founded by Meiji-era entrepreneur Denzaburo Fujita, this museum houses masterworks of Japanese antiquities.

Renovated in 2022, it blends tradition with contemporary design.

After admiring the National Treasures and exquisite tea utensils, pause to enjoy seasonal sweets and tea.

6:00 P.M. UMEDA SKY BUILDING

As the day draws to a close, head to the Umeda Sky Building, featured by The Times as one of the world's top 20 architectural landmarks. Its distinctive design, with two towers connected by an aerial bridge, provides panoramic views from the 40th-floor and rooftop Floating Garden Observatory. At the basement-level Takimi Koji, step back in time and savour local culinary delights, completing a perfect day.
