ITINERARY

09:00 A.M. OSAKA CASTLE / OSAKA MUSEUM OF HISTORY

Begin your day at one of Osaka's most iconic landmarks, Osaka Castle.

Explore the museum within the main keep before heading up to the top-floor observatory for panoramic views of the city.

A short walk brings you to the Osaka Museum of History, where the story of the city unfolds chronologically from ancient times to the modern day. Discover the flourishing merchant culture of the medieval era, when Osaka was known as "the nation's kitchen", as well as the influences of Western culture from the Meiji period.

12:00 A.M. NANONIWA

For lunch, make your way to nanoniwa, a park-integrated commercial complex situated beside the historic site of the Naniwa Palace, believed to be the stage of the Taika Reform. Surrounded by expansive lawns and open-air terraces, the area offers a serene atmosphere reminiscent of the ancient capital. With views towards Osaka Castle and a wide selection of dining options, it is an ideal spot to savour a leisurely meal in a tranquil, green setting.



ITINERARY

3:00 P.M. SUMIYOSHI TAISHA SHRINE

After taking the Tanimachi Line to Abeno Station, board the Hankai Tramway, Osaka's only remaining streetcar. Upon arriving at Sumiyoshi Torii-mae Station, you will be welcomed by Sumiyoshi Taisha, the head shrine of more than 2,300 Sumiyoshi shrines across Japan and a sacred site with over 1,300 years of history.

Highlights include the vivid vermilion Taiko Bridge, and the distinctive straight-lined architecture of the Sumiyoshi-zukuri main halls. Wander through the spacious grounds and soak in the profound sense of history and tranquillity.

6:00 P.M. HOZENJI YOKOCHO

As evening falls, head to the atmospheric Hozenji Yokocho. This narrow lane, which has preserved its charm for nearly 400 years, is best enjoyed at dusk. Visit Hozenji Temple, known for its moss-covered Mizukake Fudo deity, before strolling along the stone-paved alleys lined with traditional Japanese restaurants.

Illuminated by the gentle glow of lanterns, the area exudes a nostalgic, retro ambience. Savour a dinner that captures the refined spirit of Osaka's culinary traditions and immerse yourself in the timeless character of this historic district.
